- ★ Château Lassègue was elevated to Grand Cru Classé in 2022.
- ★ 250-year-old estate purchased by Jess Jackson, Barbara Banke and the Seillan Family in 2003.
- ★ Located on the prestigious slope of Saint Émilion (La Côte de Saint-Émilion).
- ★ Vigneron Pierre Seillan has identified 16 micro-crus at the estate.
- ★ Clay and limestone soils impart minerality, providing further complexity and concentration in the wine.
