BORDEAUX



Right Bank is an eponymous cuvée originating from the Bordeaux region.

It is on the most prestigious appellations from the right bank of the Garonne river that Vignobles K has selected some great plots of its properties to highlight the qualities of their wines in a precise blend : the structure of the Astéries limestone of Saint-Emilion, the velvetiness of the Pomerol clay, the suppleness of the Lalande de Pomerol fine gravel, and the tension and freshness of the Castillon Côtes de Bordeaux 'red limestone'.

The date of harvest, vinification and ageing are adapted to each terroir in order to respect its typical character and optimise its translation; the blend is not made until all the wines are ready. The first grapes to be harvested are those from Pomerol and Lalande de Pomerol. They are vinified in stainless steel vats and the wines are matured in one and two-wine barrels to preserve the smoothness of the former and the delicacy of the latter. After that, the Saint Emilion grapes are harvested and vinified in concrete vats. The wines are matured in new barrels (25%) and in one-wine barrels, to develop their power and tension, and to enhance their length. At the same time, the Castillon grapes reach the desired maturity. They are vinified and matured in stainless steel vats, without sulphur, to bring out their deep, luscious fruitiness, tension and freshness.

The total production of Right Bank 2022 represents 5 000 bottles presenting a blend of 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc

TASTING

Reflecting the different terroirs from which it is made, this wine has a wide range of aromas, from the freshness of blackcurrant to the sweetness of black cherry, with hints of liquorice and camphor. The first impression on the palate is supple and juicy, followed by a taut texture and a long finish.
