

Notes de dégustation - PRIMEURS 2023

COUVENT DES JACOBINS

James Suckling (95-96): *Density and fullness to this, but at the same time it is tight and formed with creamy tannins that envelop the wine. Medium to full body. Pretty blackberry and black-cherry character. Very pure. Well balanced, but so structured as well. Merlot with 11% cabernet franc and 5% petit verdot. Mostly limestone. Tasted twice.*

Wine Advocate RP (91-93): *The 2023 Couvent des Jacobins offers up attractive aromas of dark berries and cherries, mingled with hints of pencil shaving, licorice and petals. Medium to full bodied, seamless and layered, with velvety tannins and good mid-palate density, it displays plenty of potential.*

Lisa Perrotti-Brown - The Wine Independent (90-92): *Composed of 84% merlot, 11% cabernet franc and 5% petit verdot, the 2023 Couvent des Jacobins is deep garnet-purple colored with notes of blackberry pie, preserved plums, and raspberry coulis hopping from the glass, leading to hints of sassafras, black pepper, and underbrush. Medium-bodied, the palate is soft and delicate with just enough freshness and a peppery finish.*

Yves Beck (94-96): *Quel sens du détail et de la finesse dans le bouquet de Couvent des Jacobins. De multiples nuances créent un ensemble olfactif harmonieux avec, entre autres, des nuances de cerises, de sureau ainsi qu'une touche de garrigues. Le vin affiche du tempérament, des l'attaque. Il sait créer le lien entre son côté plutôt strict et les tannins aux grains fins, puis la structure acide. Cette dernière, incisive, assure la fraîcheur ainsi que le côté salin de la finale. 2028-2053.*

Markus del Monego - Tasting Book (92): *Dark purple colour with violet hue. Elegant nose with fine berry fruit reminiscent of blackberries and mulberries, balmy spices and subtle oak. On the palate well structured with ripe yet firm tannins, sweet fruit and subtle oak, good length.*

Falstaff - Peter Moser (91): *Dark ruby, opaque core, purple reflections, brightening on the rim. Dark forest berryish fruit with a tobacco and herbal savouriness in the background, orange zest. Medium complexity, ripe cherries, vivid tannins, somewhat dry in the finish, a hint of nougat in the aftertaste.*
