



ROCAS DE SEÑA 2022

Aconcagua Valley - Chile

Rocas de Seña takes its name from the rocky soils found in the Aconcagua Valley, in tribute to its geography. Those soils lend unique characteristics to the wine, and the large volcanic rocks are reminiscent of the holistic landscape in the vineyard. The launch of Seña's second wine aims to continue exploring the expression of our terroir with a unique blend from selected blocks of our Seña vineyard and the addition of the Mediterranean varieties that flourish in the Aconcagua Valley to deliver elegance and youthful freshness

VINTAGE 2022

*A harmonious and gentle growing season.
Wine of perfect balance and purity.*

The outstanding 2022 vintage benefited from ideal conditions during the growing season. The season was marked by a slightly lower crop, dry conditions, and average temperatures during the ripening period, that were perfectly in line with our historical records.

Spring presented a slightly earlier bud-break due to less rainfall than normal during the winter. Then, moderate temperatures allowed the vines to continue with regular physiological dates during the whole season with a gradual and homogeneous ripening of the grapes. This slow and steady ripening delivered perfect maturity and a wine of great balance and purity.

The biggest challenge of this season was the availability of water in the region, with only 75mm of rainfall, a 65% decrease compared to the historical average of rain in the Aconcagua Valley, that reached 219 mm. However, the deep-rooted older vines, a good irrigation strategy and the biodynamic practices, allowed us to go through the growing season gently.

The harvest kicked off on the 3rd of March with Grenache shortly followed by Syrah and continued the 16th of March with the picking of Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot finishing on the 4th of April with Mourvedre.

AGEING

18 months, 100% in French oak barrels (40% new)

"Bright ruby red, with violet tones. In the nose it is expressive and pure, revealing fresh fruit aromas of cranberries, blueberries, rosemary, dill and light notes of nutmeg. On the palate it is fresh and juicy, with a savory character with a fine, lingering finish."
