## CHÂTEAU CROIZET-BAGES 2022

Château Croizet-Bages 2022 is the « not to be missed » vintage of a family Grand Cru Classé, ideally located on the Bages plateau and steadily rising.



Presentation of Château Croizet-Bages

Château Croizet-Bages is a 5<sup>th</sup> **Classified Growth** in 1855 located in the Pauillac appellation. Its 30-hectares vineyard is located on the famous Bages plateau, between Château Grand Puy Lacoste and Château Lynch-Bages.

Property of the **Quié family** since 1942 (also owner of Château Rauzan-Gassies – 2<sup>nd</sup> Classified Growth in 1855 of the Margaux appellation), Château Croizet-Bages is now run by the 3<sup>rd</sup> generation of the family, the twins Anne- Françoise and Jean-Philippe, since 2005.

With continuity, Anne-Françoise and Jean-Philippe **are daily involved to watch, specify and improve** each stage of the winemaking processes.

Château Croizet-Bages is certified,  
**High Environmental Value 3.**

**1% Petit Verdot**

With 1/3 of Merlot, Château Croizet-Bages raises **opulent, generous, aromatic wines on a measured tannic structure**. The 2022 vintage reveals the best of each grape variety: tasty and gourmet Merlots, and expressive and sappy Cabernet Sauvignons.

Château Croizet-Bages **carries on its development**. Currently in reconstruction, new performing technical installations are rising up to be at the service of the future vintages.
